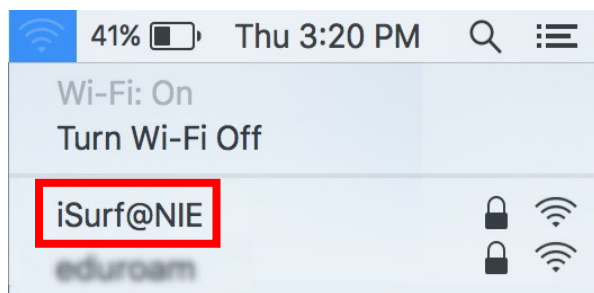
iSurf@NIE settings for Mac OS X El Capitan.

Pre-requisites

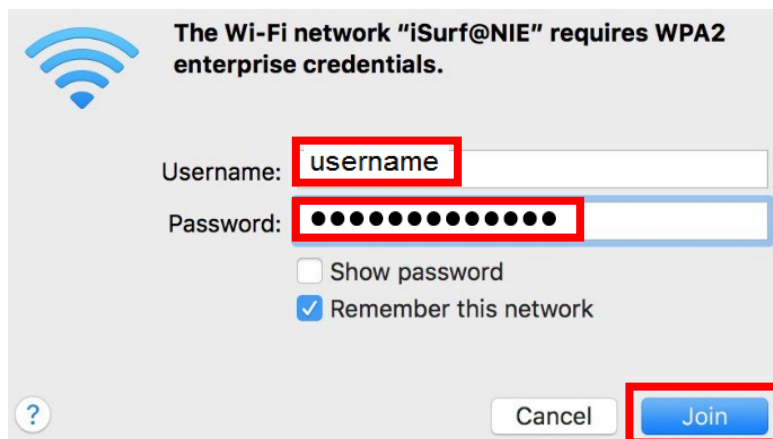
- Turn on your hardware wireless device.

Note: This guide also shows how to remove iSurf@NIE settings if you have reset your password or entered an incorrect password.

- 1) Click **WiFi icon** at top right corner and Select **iSurf@NIE**.

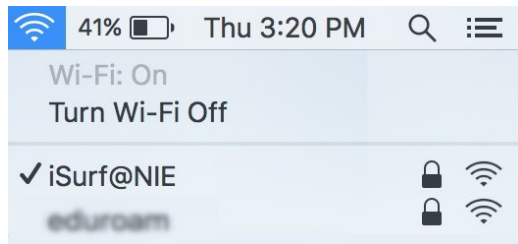


- 2) Enter your username and password. Click **Join**.



NOTE: Security Trust Settings may be prompted only for first time setup – key in **MacBook password** and click **Update Settings**. Click **Continue** when asked to Verify Certificate.

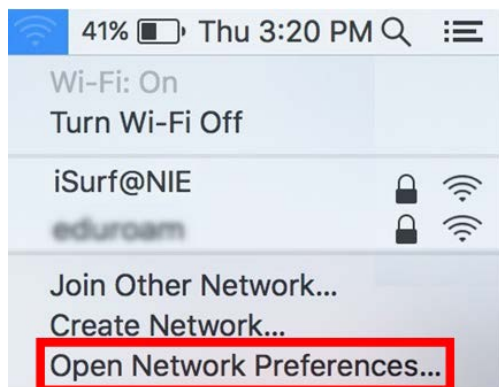
3) Once done, Mac will automatically connect to **iSurf@NIE** network.



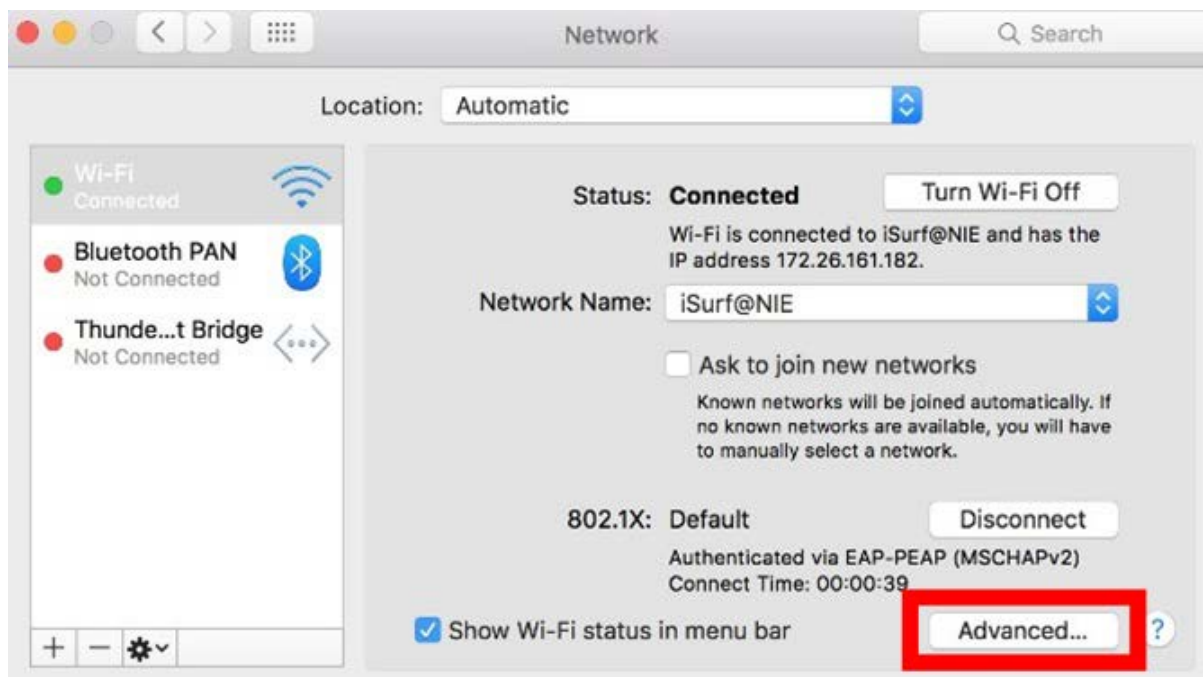

How to remove iSurf@NIE settings after password reset or incorrect password entry.

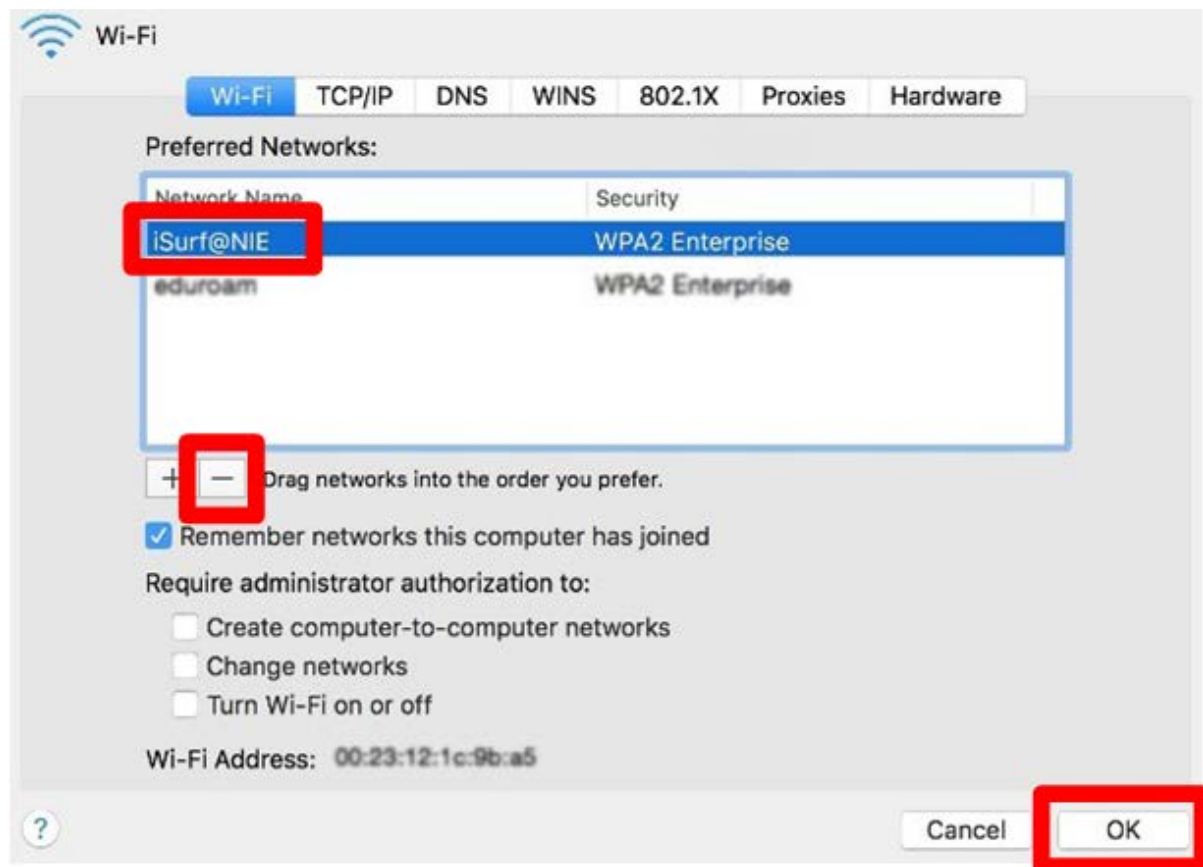
A. Click **Wifi icon** at the top right corner and Select **Open Network Preferences**.
