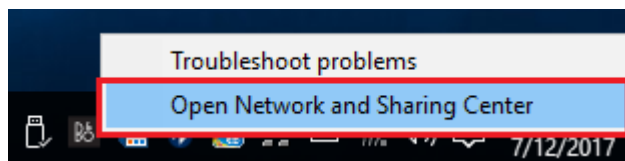


# iSurf@NIE for Windows 10

- 1) Right-click on the wireless icon on taskbar and select **Open Network and Sharing Center > Set up a new connection or network > Manually connect to a wireless network**



3) Click **Change connection settings** button

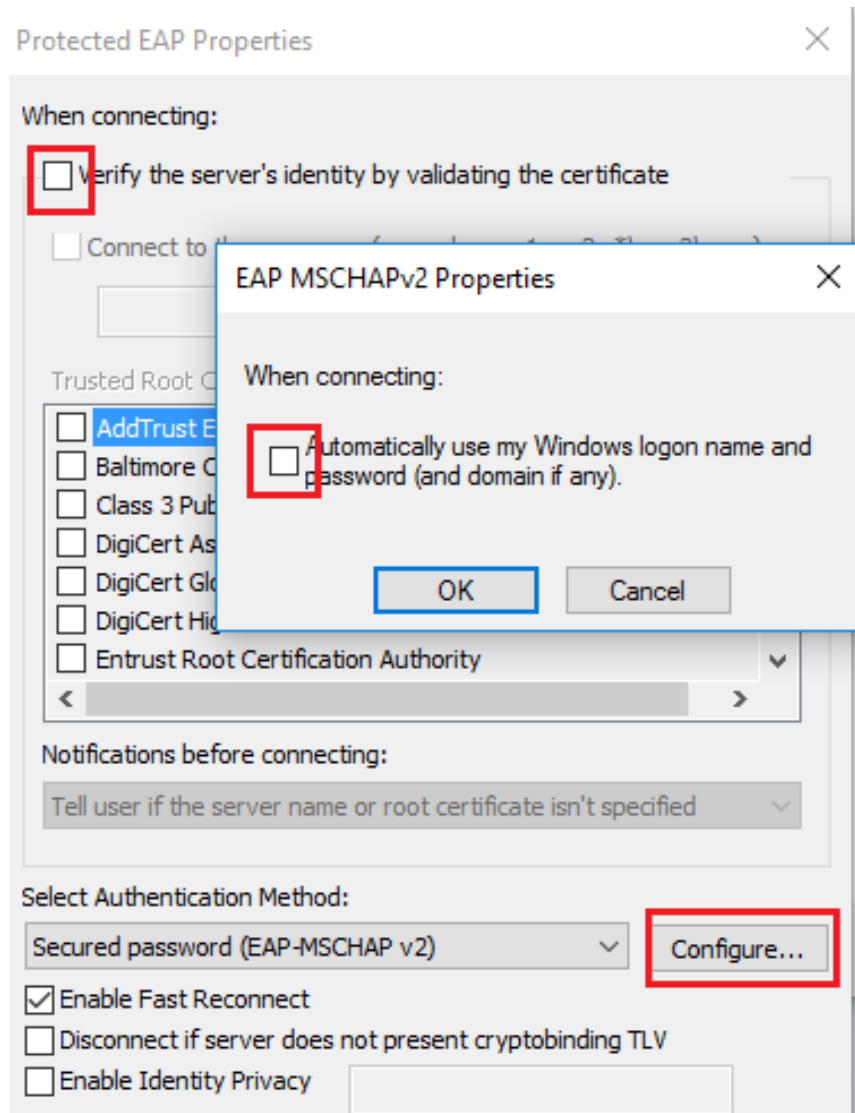
4) Under **Connection** tab, tick the **check boxes**

5) Under **Security** tab, uncheck **Remember my credentials for this connection** and click **Settings** button

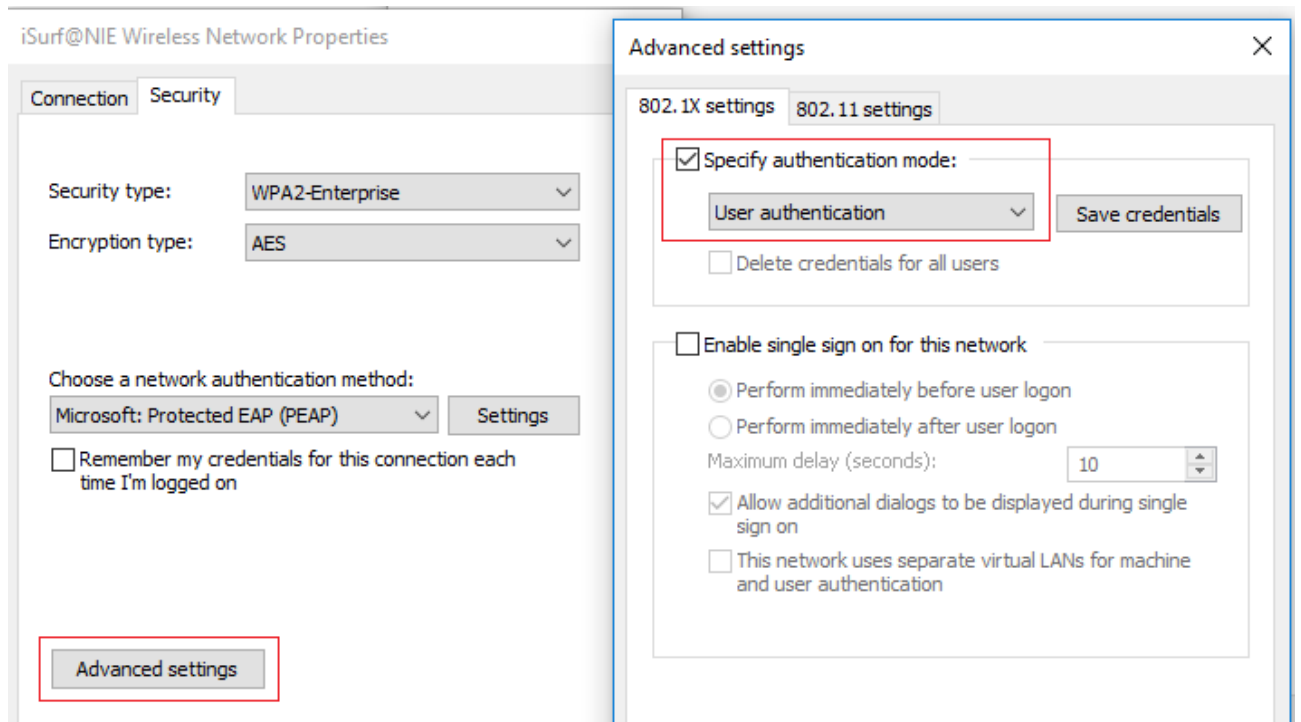


6) Uncheck the box **Verify the server's identity by validating the certificate**

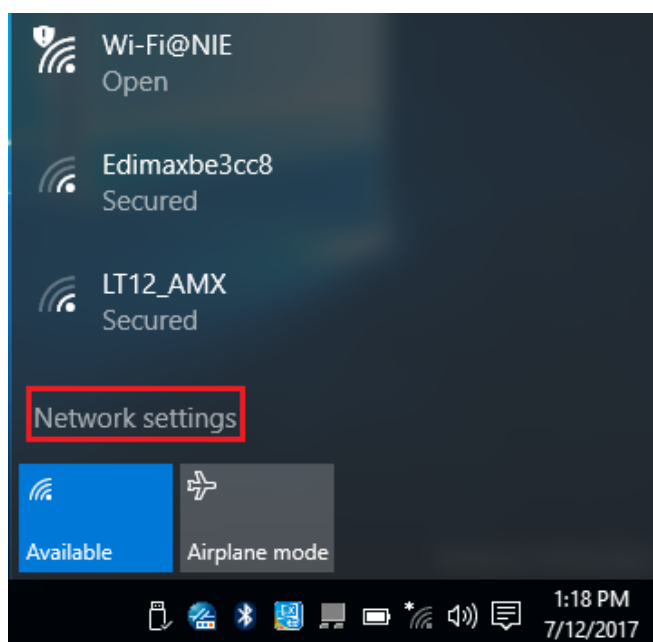
7) Click **Configure** button and uncheck the box **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)**. Click **OK** buttons to close all settings.



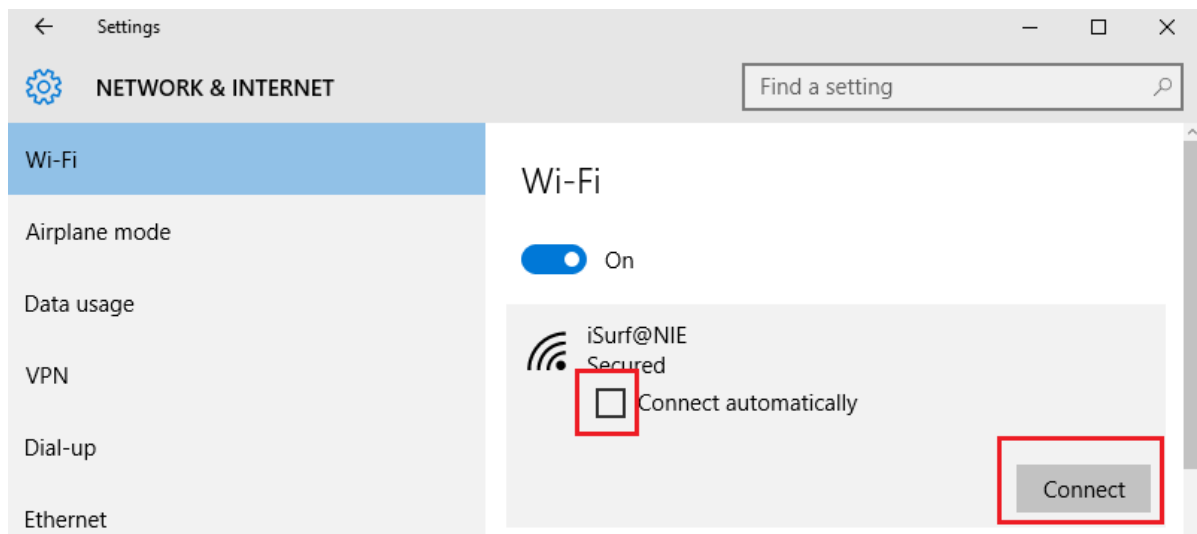
- 8) Under **Security** tab, click on **Advanced settings** button
