

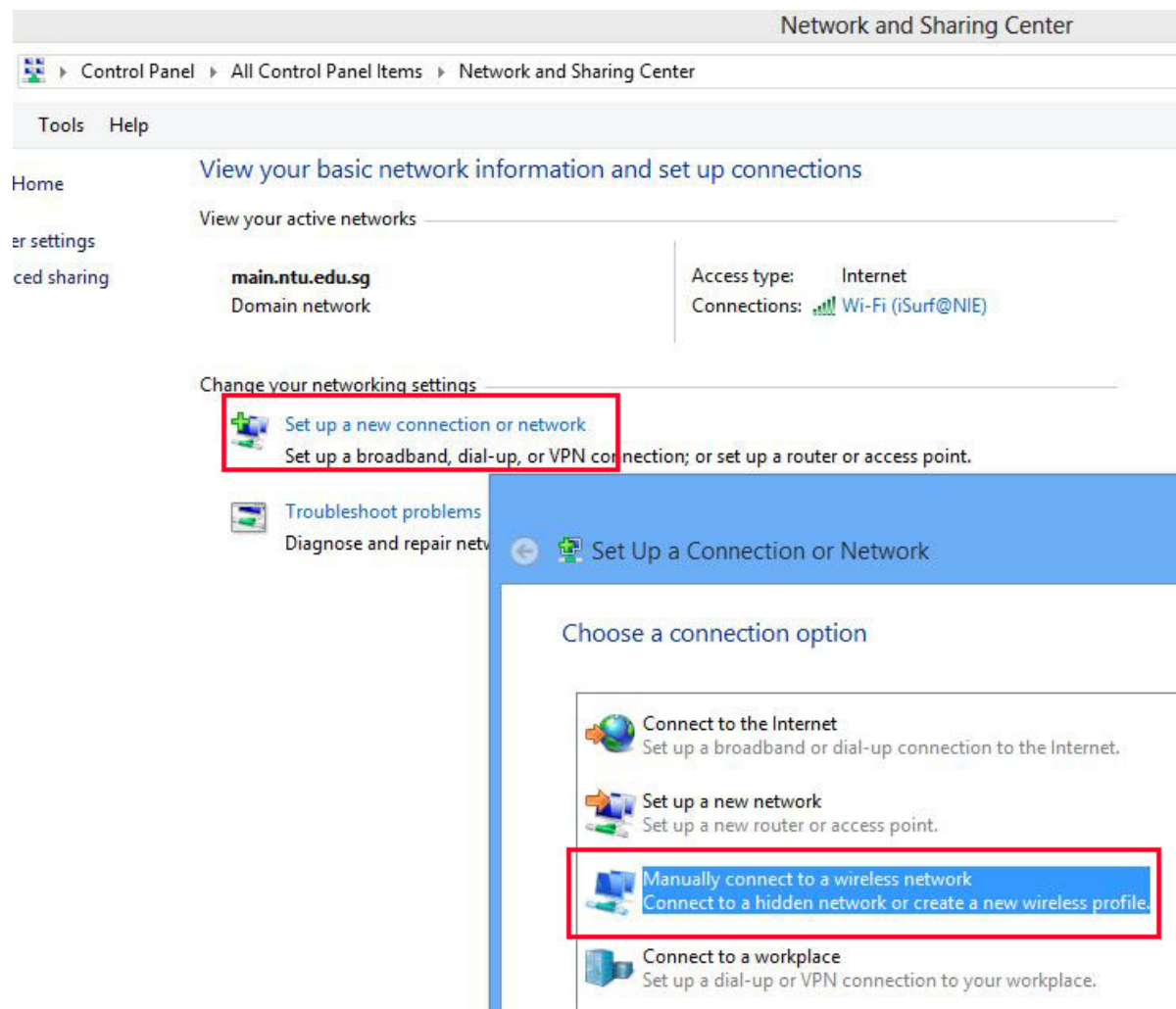
iSurf@NIE for Windows 8

iSurf@NIE settings for Windows 8.

Pre-requisites

- Turn on wireless card device.

1) Go to **Search Apps>Control Panel>Network and Sharing Center>View network status and tasks>Set up a new connection or network>Manually connect to a wireless network** and click **Next** button



2) Supply the information as below and then click **Next** button:-


Network name: **iSurf@NIE** (case-sensitive)

Security type: **WPA2-Enterprise**

Encryption type: **AES**

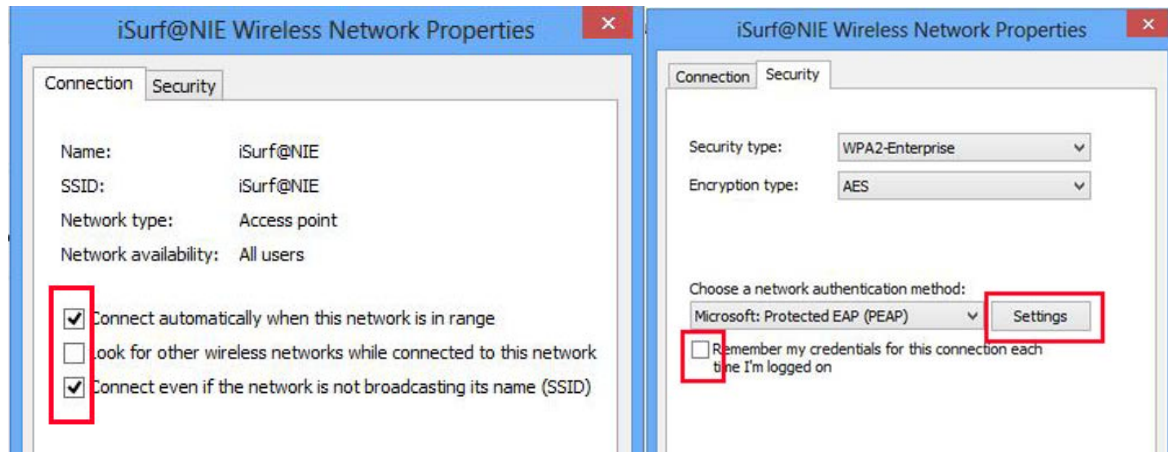

3) Click **Change connection settings** button

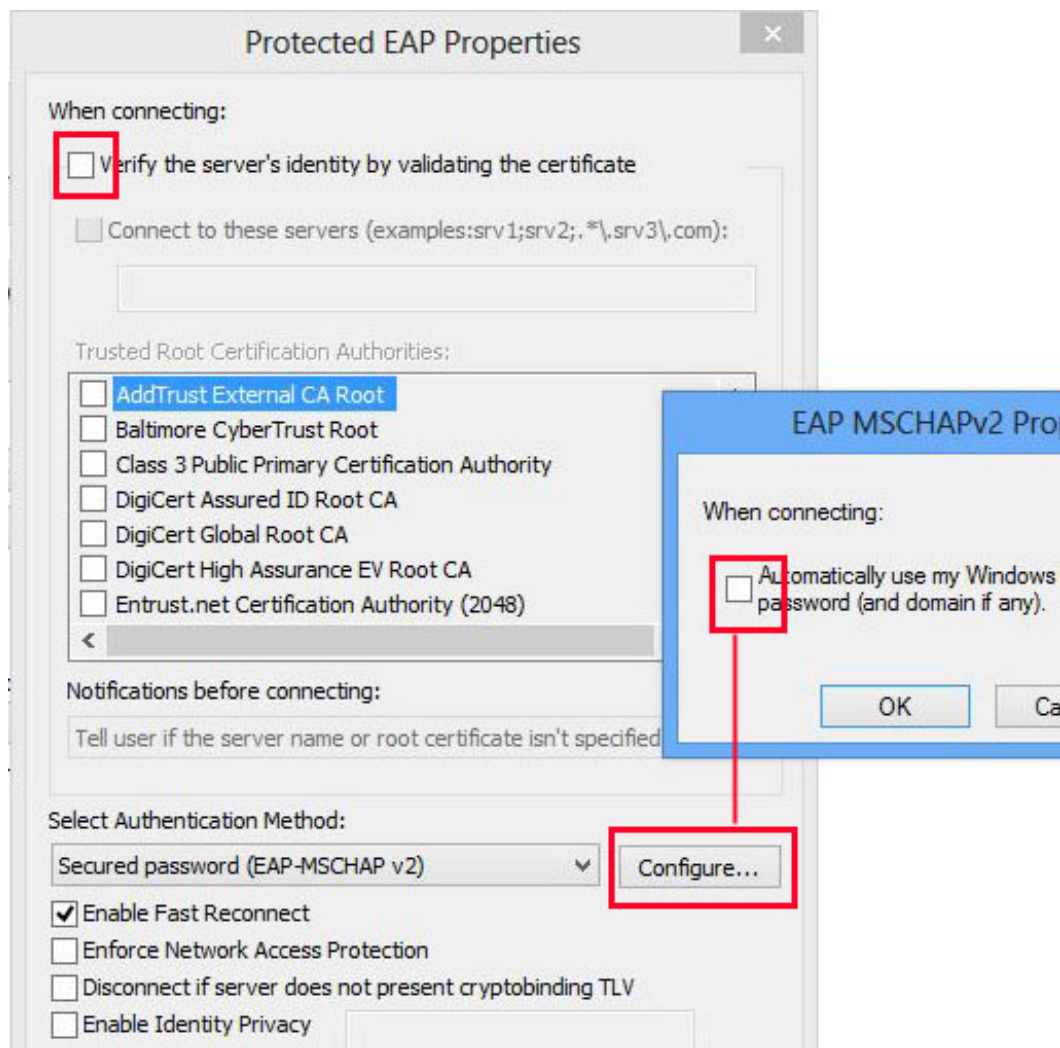
4) Under **Connection** tab, tick the **check boxes**

7) Click **Configure..** button and **uncheck** the box **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)**. Click **OK** buttons to close all settings.



8) Go to **Settings>Available** and select **iSurf@NIE** and click **Connect** button. Enter your userID and passwords under the **Network Authentication** box.
